If your policy does not cover any of these, apply for a separate travel insurance in advance. Choose the one that pays the policy holder in case of theft or occurrence of natural disasters.

Look Over Your Possessions

Tourists usually are an easy prey for them because they are easy to recognize as innocent strangers on their territory.
