# **Do You Know Procedures To Do If Your Pasport Is Damaged**

When one notices his passport is damaged the prudent action is to get a replacement right away. Immediate action prevents untoward delays in any future plans one might have in travelling. It is fortunate that right now, a clear procedure exists in having this document replaced with a new one. This article summarizes what steps there are to be done.

## Get A New One

While everyone has the right to say that the damage is only minor and his passport is still valid, such thinking is actually counter-productive. He should anticipate this scenario happening to him one day. He is in a foreign land handing his passport to the inspector. The inspector notices the damage and declares that it is invalid. He is denied entry and all that money is wasted. Incidents like this have happened. What is unfortunate is that the inspector has the last word and nothing can be done to change it.

## Form DS-11

Those getting a replacement for a damaged passport are considered new applicants. So they have to gather the required paperwork for a new application. These documents are a certified birth certificate and a completed Form DS-11. They also need to get a passport-sized photo.

## Birth Certificate

Long-time passport holders who are getting a replacement should know about a recent ruling regarding the use of the birth certificate as an attachment to the application. This rule states that this document should now contain the names of the applicant's parents. When these names are not present, it means that the application cannot proceed. The missing data must be provided by the applicant.

## You May Have To Go In Person

After completing the paperwork, the applicants have to present themselves at the nearest acceptance center. They will be interviewed and their documents inspected. After satisfying the documentation, they will be asked to pay for the replacement processing fee. There are two types of fees. One is for a regular application and the other is for the expedited processing fee.

## Expedited Processing

The faster process is more expensive and it already includes payment for the application and an express delivery of the replacement papers. An expedited process will take three weeks or less to accomplish. A regular application for replacing the document takes not less than a month to finish.

## Processing Fee

After one week has passed after paying the processing fee, the status of your application can be monitored on line. This web tracking service is available to all applicants provided they log in with their last names, date of birth, and the last four parts of their Social Security Number. Note that this is a free service.

After getting the replacement, the owners should be more careful in handling their passports. This could be one of the most important personal documents anyone can possess. While it is true that money was spent in replacing this document, the cost is very small compared to cancelled flights and tickets the moment it is realized that your passport is invalid.
