There are many forms of Hong Kong apartments and you should understand them all before you make the decision about where you should rent. At a higher level there are temporary apartments i.e. holiday apartments. There are serviced apartments. And there are long term apartments. All are offered to rent.

With Hong Kong serviced apartments you ought to think about Chi Homes or Shama. Many of them charge up to \$50k HKD monthly for a 2 bedroom place.

With regard to holiday rentals you can look at googling Hong Kong holiday rentals and it comes up with a list of web sites offering holiday rentals.

With regard to long term [apartments in Hong Kong](#) you want to be speaking to local real estate agents and get them to provide you with a listing of what's available. At a higher level there are: 1) Chinese walk ups, outdated buildings that are cheaper to rent however have no lift 2) Contemporary multi-complex apartments which rents are pushed higher by locals or 3) federal government housing generally around the Kowloon area.

A advised tip when hunting for accommodation in Hong Kong. Be sure you look around and check for price ranges. Real estate agents tend to be well known for pricing items with a premium so you've already been cautioned.
