3. Hawaii Tropical Botanical Garden

4. Puuhonua O Honaunau Historic Park

Several interesting things can be seen while visiting Puuhonua O National Historic Park like black lava rock formations, sacred temples and even wooden statues of ancient local gods, not to mention the breathtaking nature. A number of tours are readily available also, which include hiking and fishing outings.

South and north sections of the island also feature a number of the favorite places of interest, like Parker Ranch or Ka Lea South Point.
