Such hotels can be found in quiet locations such as Jimbaran, Sanur, Amed, or Lovina.

The primary tourist precinct is situated at the southeastern part of Bali. But if you desire to see more specific areas of Bali, you may want to book a hotel in that specific area. For example, Lovina is a popular place for dolphin watching. For snorkelers, you can stay in a [cheap hotels](#) in Amed.
