Travel Tips for Tourists Visiting Kenya and China

Travelers have many reasons for choosing the locations they visit. Some do it out of curiosity. Some tourists travel to distant destinations because they want to experience other cultures. Here are some of the things you should remember if you've visiting China, Kenya or both. These tips are for people living in the USA.

Passports

Passport renewal due dates are a huge deal if you plan on visiting a faraway country. You should also check if the passports of your companions are about to expire. Validity of the passport must extend beyond six months from the date you plan on returning to the USA. It's nearly impossible to get a visa to anywhere if your passport is about to expire.

Downloadable Visa Forms

The internet has made it possible to quickly download a form from the official website of the country you are visiting. This goes for both Kenya and China visa applications. These forms are sometimes available from travel agency websites, especially those offering US passport services.

For business trips to china, you may have to present proof that you are there on business. You may also be required to disclose your travel information like how long you will be staying. To be safe, have a set date for returning to the USA.

Can you simply go there and then secure a visa while on location? Yes. Be warned, though. The queue for this may be a mile long during tourist season. Applying for a visa in this manner can take some time as so many people go for this route. For China, you can make Hong Kong your gateway and obtain a visa from there.

But it's still better to plan ahead if you don't want to trouble yourself with long lines. One good thing to do is to find an agency or any US passport services enterprise to help you out before your trip.

30-Day Travel Rules

You may be familiar with some 30-day travel rules. For Kenya, your tourist visa only lasts for 30 days. For China, you can forgo applying for a visa if you only intend to stay in Hong Kong for under 30 days. You should take care to plan your travel time so that you get a lot of things done in the 30 days that you can stay in that country. Consultation with a travel agent can be the best thing you can do if you want your visit to be as hassle-free as possible.
